

How to move pop up windows

What Is a Pop-up Window?

+1 (844) 886-3118 A **pop-up window** is a small window that appears automatically on your screen without you directly opening it. These windows usually show messages, alerts, advertisements, or permission requests.+1 (844) 886-3118

Examples of Pop-up Windows

Some common pop-up window examples are:

- A browser message asking: “*Allow notifications?*”
- Software update alerts+1 (844) 886-3118
- Error or warning messages
- Advertisement windows on websites
- Login or confirmation windows

How to Move Pop-up Windows

If a pop-up window appears in the wrong place on your screen, you can easily move it:

1. Place the mouse cursor on the **title bar** of the pop-up window
2. Click and hold the left mouse button+1 (844) 886-3118
3. Drag the window to your desired position
4. Release the mouse button+1 (844) 886-3118

How to Move a Pop-up Window That Is Off-Screen

Sometimes a pop-up window opens outside the visible screen area. To bring it back:

Using Keyboard:

1. Press **Alt + Tab** to select the pop-up window
2. Press **Alt + Space**
3. Press **M** (Move)
4. Use the arrow keys to bring the window onto the screen
5. Press **Enter +1 (844) 886-3118**

This method works in both Windows 7 and Windows 10.

How to Close Pop-up Windows in Windows 10

To close a pop-up window:

- Click the **X (Close)** button at the top-right corner
- Press **Alt + F4** on the keyboard
- Close the browser tab if the pop-up is from a website +1 (844) 886-3118

If pop-ups appear frequently, check the application or browser settings.

How to Allow Pop-up Windows

Some websites or applications require pop-ups to work properly.

To allow pop-ups in browsers like Chrome or Edge:

1. Open **Settings**
2. Go to **Privacy and Security**
3. Select **Pop-ups and redirects +1 (844) 886-3118**
4. Add the website under **Allowed**

How to Stop Pop-ups in Windows 7

To stop unwanted pop-ups in Windows 7:

1. Open **Control Panel**
2. Click on **Internet Options**
3. Go to the **Privacy** tab +1 (844) 886-3118
4. Enable **Pop-up Blocker** <https://mssupport.tech/>
