

Pop up window opening off screen

A pop-up window that opens off-screen can be fixed **+1 (844) 886-3118** by using keyboard shortcuts such as Alt+Spacebar, then M, then an arrow key to move it back. You can also try right-clicking <https://mssupport.tech/> the application on the taskbar and choosing Move, or you can use the Windows key + Arrow keys after choosing the window. These techniques assist in bringing the window back into your view. This typically occurs with multi-monitor setups or display adjustments. **+1 (844) 886-3118**

Choose Cascade windows from the option that appears when you right-click on the Windows taskbar.**+1 (844) 886-3118**

- In the Windows taskbar, right-click on the relevant application icon while holding down the Shift key.**+1 (844) 886-3118**

Choose the Move option from the resulting pop-up.

To move the invisible window <https://mssupport.tech/> from off-screen to on-screen, start using your keyboard's arrow keys. To shift the window from right to left, you usually use the left arrow.**+1 (844) 886-3118**

To access the system menu in the window, press Alt + Space. To choose Move from the context menu, press M. **+1 (844) 886-3118** To return the window to the visible screen area, use the arrow keys. To complete the window's location, press Enter.

The procedures listed below can be used to recover the lost component.

- Verify that the window or dialog has focus by making it the active window.**+1 (844) 886-3118**
- To switch to move mode, press Alt+Spacebar+M.
- To snap the window position to the mouse, press any arrow key.
- The window will show up wherever you move the mouse.**+1 (844) 886-3118**
