

How to stop mcafee popups ?

To stop McAfee pop-ups, start by adjusting settings 1*888*329*8318 within the McAfee application. Open McAfee, navigate to General Settings, then Informational Alerts, and turn off unnecessary notifications. 1*888*329*8318 This reduces alerts from the software itself. Next, manage notifications at the operating system level. On Windows, go to Settings > System > Notifications, locate McAfee in the list of apps, and disable notifications.
