

# What is going on with SBCGlobal.net email? (Correct Settings Here!!!)

These email accounts are now managed through AT&T's system and accessed via Yahoo Mail. While new accounts are no longer created, **+1 (888) 769 5906** existing users can still log in. If you're having trouble accessing your SBCGlobal email, call **+1 (888) 769 5906** or **(888) 769 5906** for 24/7 support.

SBCGlobal.net email **isn't shutting down**, **+1 (888) 769 5906** but it's a **legacy service now managed through AT&T Mail** and hosted by Yahoo — not a standalone platform anymore.
