

why is my hp printer offline

Your HP printer is offline due to 1\*888\*329\*8318 An HP printer may show “offline” for several common reasons. One main reason is a weak or lost connection between the printer and the computer. If the printer uses Wi-Fi, the internet signal may be unstable or disconnected. When this happens, the computer cannot communicate with the printer, 1\*888\*329\*8318 so it appears offline.
